we worked together towards a solution, KTR proposed a contract modification that incorporated the temporary storm water control measures into the final design, new design improved the original range layout, and resulted in a credit back to the Government without sechedule impact. They were very responsive with the engineering analysis and redisign for that proposal. Their submittal was comprehensive and required only a few minor anjustments based on the Government review and appproval. 17.(e)(q)

Completion of punchlist items, and warranty response

KTR executed their own punchlist prior to pre-final inspection. USACE personel found that KTR's punchlist was infact more comprehensive than suspected. The items from this early generated punchlist were complete, which resulted in a more concise final punchlist from USACE. The KTR executed resolution to all punchlist items within a three day time frame which resulted in DPW taking possession the day of the final walk .

CONTRACTOR REMARKS: This was the initial project for RACC as a General Contractor. Our core business philosophies of teamwork and partnering and coinciding approach to the project from USACE Personnel were absolute key in the successful completion of the project.

As stated there were substantial environmental constraints levied early on in the project and the ensuing cooperation from USACE was instrumental in redesigning and constructing the project in an efficient and environmentally responsible manner. The Win-Win Team atmosphere working with USACE and Fort Sill Personnel was thoroughly professional and made for a very satisfying and rewarding working climate.

A tremendous sense of pride and accomplishment was enjoyed by all RACC Project Personnel from Upper Management throughout the ranks of labor. We look forward to future projects with the Fort Sill Team and we salute them. The opportunity to serve and support our troops was and continues to be a unique and fulfilling experience for the entire RACC Organization.
